A selected set of papers presented at the ITNG 2012 will be considered for publication in a special issue of Int. J. of Communication, Networks and Systems Science.

THEME:

Information Security and Privacy is a growing concern in today's networked world. This track will be devoted to security and privacy—its technological, commercial, legal, and social aspects. Papers dealing with the following privacy-related topics are welcome.

- Identity theft and related abuses;
- Consumer and business practices and trends affecting privacy;
- Information ownership, competing claims, unresolved ambiguity;
- Electronic Payments;
- Legal and criminal issues;
- Privacy leakage case studies;
- Relationships between privacy management and digital rights management;
- Formal models and definitions of privacy;
- Privacy leakage case studies;
- Relationships and trade-offs between security and privacy;
- e-Marketplace;
- Information Assurance;
- Efficient Encryption/Decryption Transformation;
- Transmission of Information;
- Forensic Aspects of Communication; and
- Privacy-enhancing technologies.

PAPER SUBMISSION:

Papers should be original and contain contributions of theoretical or experimental nature, or be unique experience reports. Interested authors should submit a 6-page summary of their original and unpublished work including 5 keywords in the IEEE format to the track. EVALUATION PROCESS:

Papers will be evaluated for originality, significance, clarity, and soundness. Per ITNG policy, except for invited papers, all papers will be reviewed by at least two independent reviewers. Accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings with an ISBN.

BEST STUDENT PAPER:

The Best Student Paper will be awarded at the conference. To be eligible, the student must be the sole author of the paper, or the first author and primary contributor.
